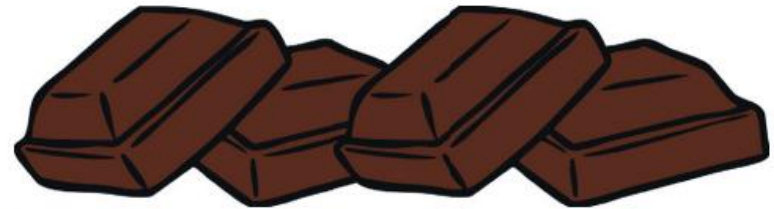


Addition and Subtraction Word Problems - Adults read out the question and children try and answer. You can use objects to help you.

If you had 10 glass bottles and 3 of them smashed, how many of them would you have left?



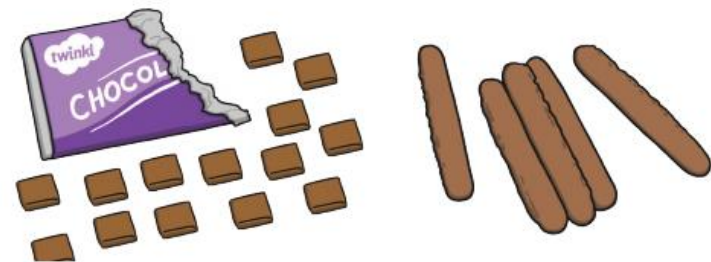
If you had 20 squares of chocolate and you ate 15 of them, how many would you have left?

If you had 14 squares of chocolate and 5 chocolate fingers, how many do you have in total?



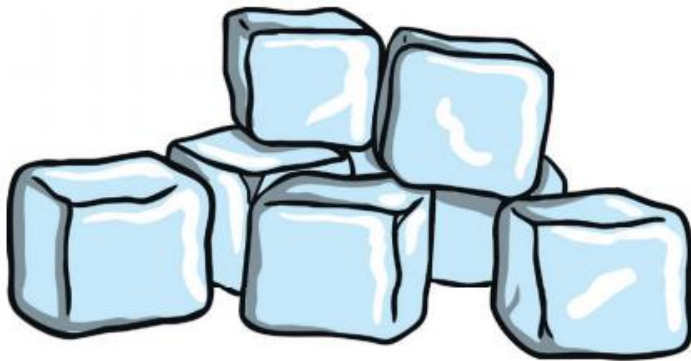
If you have 5 blackbirds and 9 robins in your garden, how many are there?
