

## Week 4 Topic - Science- Shadow Puppets

# Shadow Puppet

You will need:

- Animal Shadow Puppets Cut-Out Sheet
- Stick (such as a lollypop stick)
- Sticky tape
- Scissors
- White paper
- A torch



### Activity 1

Make a shadow puppet by cutting out one of the animals from the sheet and attaching it to a stick.

Hold the torch directly above the piece of paper. Put the puppet in front of the torch. Move the puppet closer to the torch and then further away.
