LO: I can explain which countries supported each other and which stayed neutral during World War 1.

We've looked at World War 2 this week, through the experience of a British evacuee. But World War 1 is also an extremely important War to remember also. It was from 1914-1918 and it was between the UK and Germany. There were lots of other European countries caught up in the turmoil.

The term Triple entente is what we call countries that join to create something called an alliance. This is a support group where each country is equal in importance and looks after one another. During WW1, the UK, France and the Russian Empire were one and Germany, Austria-Hungary and Italy were another.

Have a look at the map of Europe and colour in the different alliances, each one will need to be a different colour and there is a key on the right hand side. There is a help sheet for you. Don't rush, take your time to create a clear and neat map.
