## **Our Recovery Curriculum.**

The Covid-19 Pandemic that we as a nation are experiencing has impacted so many lives and will have impacted the educational opportunities of many children. Due to the circumstances that different families have encountered, children will have received a spectrum of home learning support. It is therefore essential that school provide **all** children with essential learning from their previous year group to enable them to progress forward equally, while also providing opportunities to challenge and enhance the learning of children who are ready to deepen their understanding of the skills and knowledge gained from the home learning provided during the lock-down period.

The goal is to have provided all the essential learning from a child's previous year group and completed all the learning for the new year group by the end of this Academic Year (20/21). This is not an easy thing as our curriculum is already overflowing with content that must be covered this year anyway.

The teaching staff have identified those areas of the curriculum that need to be 'caught up' or covered again and since September have used assessments and observations to see which objectives need a focus for particular groups of children. Interventions and strategies have then been in place, through quality first teaching, small group learning and where applicable 1:1 support.

Teachers identify on their planning documents which objectives are 'catch-up' objectives so that we can see that we are aiming to cover these before we move on to ensure that new skills and knowledge are built up effectively. We have planned carefully how to use the government 'Covid-19 Catch Up Grant' and a copy of our planned spend is on our website.
