English: For the next 2 days we are going to be looking at the story *A Place for Plastic*. It's about a plastic bag and it's journey after it has been thrown in the bin. Read the story on the power point, have a really good look at the pictures. What can you see? What colours are being used? How do the pictures make you feel? What do you think happens to the sea life when they eat the plastic bag by mistake? Use the images to create your own plastic bag story on the writing sheet provided. You could tell it in the first person (the point of view of the bag) or you could tell it in the third person (as a narrator). Why not experiment with alliteration, rhyming words and figurative language (adding colour, touch and feelings to your writing). Be creative and let your mind wander, please don't rush this activity, this exercise will take time if you do it properly, therefore I've given you 2 days to complete it.
