Today you will have 4 pieces of work to complete: Maths, English, PSHE and Music

Maths

Today the work set is slightly different: you have one last lesson and video for the unit and then you need to complete an end of unit assessment to check your understanding of the work from the last few weeks. Main Maths

Support Maths

Then answer the assessment questions on **multiplication and division** and circle how confident you feel on this subject (from 1-5) on the self-assessment section at the bottom of the 2nd sheet. Remember to mark all your work before you submit it.

English

Today you will be finishing the biography on your chosen author by writing a conclusion and then editing and improving your work. Please read the English instruction sheet for more details.

PSHE and Citizenship

Our focus for this term is 'Positive Thinking' and our third lesson is all about understanding the consequences of different choices.

- First read the powerpoint
- Then pick one of the scenarios the children face in the powerpoint and complete the Decision-Making Tree Activity Sheet to show the thought process behind making an informed decision.

Music

We will be starting a new sequence of lessons that Oak Academy have produced on the topic of 'metre'. There are 6 lessons that build on your knowledge and have lots of fun activities for you to try at home. There is no need to submit any written work for this but you could click 'turn in' on the assignment if you manage to access the lesson online.

In this lesson, you will warm-up by moving to the pulse, and identifying different beats of the bar. Following that, you will learn two songs which can be performed with a cup pattern (if you want to do this you will need 2 plastic cups). Finally, you will understand simple musical notation and compose your own three beat pattern.
