Good morning everyone and well done to those of you who managed to complete your home learning yesterday.

Today you have been set 4 pieces of work: Maths, English, Science and PE

Maths

To start the morning, we'd like you to complete the arithmetic sheet. The top set of questions are harder and the questions at the bottom are easier – copy out the questions which you would usually do in class and answer them. You could use a calculator to check your answers if you can, or submit them and I can give you feedback.

Today you will focus on **Three Decimal Places**. Watch the related video <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-6/week-1-number-decimals/> and answer the questions. Then you can complete the related true or false question to check your understanding. When you have finished, as an extra task there is an 'Among us Challenge' – there are 10 arithmetic questions, which have answers, but there are two imposters (incorrect answers). Your task is to find the imposters.

English

Today's lesson is about identifying the features of a biography.
