Good morning, Topaz! Thank you for the lovely work you have been handing in so far this week. We have really enjoyed looking at it and are very proud of what you are doing!

Today, we have some Maths, English, Science and PE for you to do at home. We look forward to seeing what you complete!

In maths today, we are finishing our unit on Multiplication and Division. We have a division sheet that we would like you to try and do completely by yourself. If you are unsure of any questions, think back to similar questions we have done over the last few weeks; there is nothing new on the sheet. Adults can certainly read the question to you if you don't know what it says. If at the end, there is a question you were unsure of, your adult can help you with it on the back of the sheet so you know for another time, but leave your answer on the sheet as you had it yourself. As this is a review of your learning, there is no video today.

Remember, if you are quick to finish, you can go onto Times table Rockstars or complete your own times table practice.

In English, we will continue with our Thursday reading focus. This week, we will use the 'Sequencing Suki' character to help learn our new reading skill. There is a powerpoint to show you how she can help you with your reading. Then there is a choice of three reading comprehensions to do which practice the sequencing skill. Choose your favourite comprehension to do, or if you have time spare, you could complete some of the other ones. If you find the reading tricky, ask an adult to read it to you. The focus today is an understanding the text and using the skill, rather than the actual reading of the words.

This afternoon, we have our science session with Mrs Kite. This week, we will be continuing with our topic on animals and humans. Today, we will learn about how humans grow and change. Please look at the task sheet which will show you what to do.
