## **Art and Computing Instructions**

For your work this afternoon, you will have an art lesson (drawing a Pop Art repeated image self-portrait) then a computing activity (practising your keyboard and typing skills). Please read through **all** of this document before you start.

For art, you will need to go through the input PowerPoint first (the file named [Pop Art Portraits Input PowerPoint.pptx](#)). Like yesterday's PSHE, I have added a narration where I read through the information. At the start there is a video to watch as well. If viewing the PowerPoint on the slideshow view, you can click the play symbol that you will see on slide 3 and it takes you to the video. I have also included the website link for you to copy and paste into your browser.

As yesterday, you need to play the PowerPoint to get the narration. If you have downloaded the file, just looking at the slides as they appear when you open the file does not play the narration. You also do not need to click to go the next slide if watching the PowerPoint under *Slide Show/Play from Start*- the slides will move on by themselves due to the timings I have set up.

After going through the input PowerPoint you will then need to draw your own Pop Art repeated image self-portrait on paper. The instructions are in a separate PowerPoint- due to a limit on file sizes I had to do the instructions separately (it is the file named [Pop Art Portraits Instructions PowerPoint.pptx](#)). In this PowerPoint there are step by step instructions with photographs, taken as I was doing my example. This PowerPoint is also narrated but I know that you will not be able to do each step as quickly as I am reading. I would suggest playing each slide, then exiting the play view to do the step. Then play the PowerPoint again from the next slide to continue listening to my narration. I have attached the actual self-portrait instructions (the same as we had last week) in a separate file, due to file size limitations. It is the file name [Self Portrait Instructions.pdf](#)

If you prefer you can just read the slides yourself on the normal view and go to the next slide when you are ready! I look forward to seeing your work!

If you could upload your finished drawing as a photograph and submit it with the assignment so I can see your drawing that would be great. Or you can email a photo of your work to [home.learning@kcs.bwmat.org](mailto:home.learning@kcs.bwmat.org) If emailing, please put my name in the subject line so I know it is for me.

For computing, you will continue with the next 2 activities from Unit 1 of the computing game that I introduced you to last week. This game works both on a computer/laptop and a tablet.

On the right-hand side, click/tap on **Start Learning**. In the drop-down menu, click/tap on **K-2 Elementary** (this is the American version of KS1 in primary school. Later we will move on to Upper Elementary which is the American version of KS2 in primary school). On the page that will now appear, click/tap on **Unit 1 My Keyboard Adventure**. There are 6 activities for Unit 1. **Today I would like you to do just two of the activities- 3. Cupcake Bugs and 4. Astro Bubbles.** These 2 games have lots of levels each, but they are quite short so that will be enough for this afternoon.
