Computing and Art Instructions

As you know, today is Safer Internet Day. So for computing today we will be looking at what we mean by being safe online and how you can stay safe online. This is especially important this year because we are having to spend so much time on computers and tablets and going on to the Internet to do our learning.

I have put the art in with computing as one assignment this afternoon because the art is going to be based on what you have learnt in computing!

To start, please open the PowerPoint titled [Internet Safety 09.02.21 Narrated.pptx](#) and read or listen to me read the slides. There is lots of information included- the Zip It, Block It, Flag It part is especially useful.

Once you have done this, please open the attached PDF file titled [Safer Internet Day Activity.pdf](#) - there are some questions on here I would like you to look at. This PDF is an Interactive PDF- this means that you can click to put a tick in the boxes to show your answer to the question and type straight into boxes- it's very clever! To get the interactive feature, you will need to download the file to your computer, go to your Downloads folder and open it. The interactive feature does not work if you open the PDF in Teams or as a new tab in your internet browser. Once you have inputted your answers you can save the file, upload it as an attachment to the assignment and submit it so I can see your work. Or you can print it off and handwrite your answers if that is easier. Page 2 and Page 3 are the most useful if you would only like to answer some of the questions.

For your art activity this afternoon, I would like you to make an Internet safety poster. Think about what you have learnt today about how to be safe online and what you already know. You could make a poster about Zip It, Block It, Flag It. You can do the poster however you like- try to use colour and pictures to make it really eye catching. I have found some poster templates that look like a computer screen

and a tablet screen if you wanted to use those- I have attached these with the assignment. But you don't have to use them!
